The AST-points are integrated into well-established counselling organizations for migrants and provide counselling services according to § 5 Recognition and Assessment Act (AuBG).

- clarification of necessity and possibility of formal recognition
- cost coverage of certified translations of documents
- assistance with the application for assessment
- if necessary, assistance during recognition proceedings
- assistance on search for „bridging courses“ and its financing

Project objectives

AST provide professional counselling and support on recognition issues. Main target is improvement of migrants' integration into the Austrian labour market, in particular to enhance employability suited to their qualification. Another major focus is networking and cooperation within relevant institutions and organizations on regional, national and EU level.
