



Contact points for people with qualifications obtained abroad

Since January 2013, five Contact Points (AST) in Vienna, Linz, Graz, and Innsbruck have been offering advice on the recognition and evaluation of qualifications obtained abroad. In the other federal states, weekly consultation days are held. The Contact Points are advisory centers within the meaning of Section 5 of the Recognition and Evaluation Act (AuBG).

The Contact Points are coordinated and supported throughout Austria by the Contact Point coordination office.

Objective

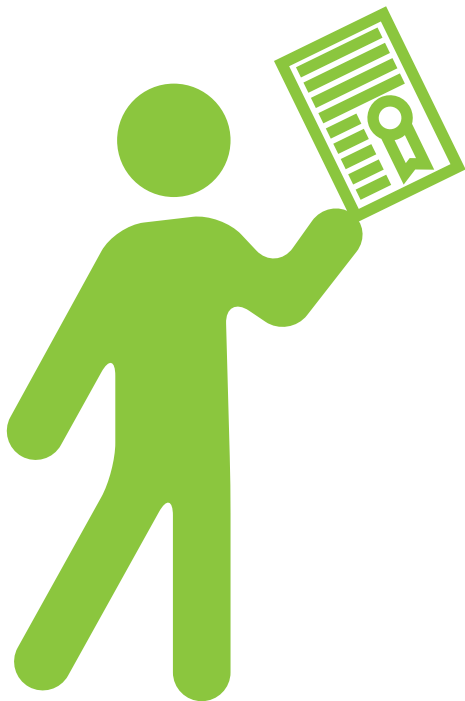
Free, multilingual information, advice, and support throughout the recognition and assessment process to facilitate integration into the labour market matching qualifications.

Target group

People with formal qualifications acquired abroad who have questions about the recognition or professional utilization of their qualifications and who reside in Austria

Services offered by the contact points

- Multilingual recognition advice, free of charge
- Clarification of whether formal recognition is necessary/possible
- Support with obtaining certified translations of diplomas and certificates
- Support with applying for evaluations and formal recognition
- Support with the recognition process, if necessary
- Information about further education and counselling options
